WHEREAS, the Beeline Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special-purpose government organized and existing under and pursuant to Chapters 189 and 190, Florida Statutes, as amended; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2024, the Florida Legislature adopted House Bill 7013, codified as Chapter 2024-136, Laws of Florida, and creating Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted Resolution 2024-05 on August 20, 2024, establishing goals and objectives for the District and creating performance measures and standards to evaluate the District's achievement of those goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes, the District must adopt and publish on its website an annual report prior to December 1st of each year, describing the goals and objectives achieved by the district, as well as the performance measures and standards used by the district to make this determination, and any goals or objectives the district failed to achieve.

WHEREAS, the District Manager has the annual report of the District's goals, objectives, and performance measures and standards attached hereto and made a part hereof as **Exhibit A** (the "Annual Report") and presented the Annual Report to the Board of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board of Supervisors ("Board") finds that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt by resolution the attached annual report of the goals, objectives and performance measures and standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BEELINE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, THAT:

SECTION 1. The recitals so stated are true and correct and by this reference are incorporated into and form a material part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The District Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Annual Report regarding the District's success or failure in achieving the adopted goals and objectives and directs the District Manager to take all necessary actions to comply with Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded or repealed.

Dear Mr. Wodraska:

Bishop Environmental Specialists, Inc. ("BES") is pleased to offer the following BCDD ball park storm water pump station progress report.

Storm Water Pump Station (Scope D)

BES personnel have monitored as described in approved Scope D and continue recording canal levels on both the intake and discharge side of the pump station as well as pump/gate operation and elapsed time readings. BES has performed weekly functional and load testing for gates, pumps and the emergency generator and is monitoring system telemetry for operational status changes.

The system operated as designed throughout the previous month. BES staff periodically lubricated the gate guides, reducing friction and avoiding the operating motor overloads witnessed earlier. There have been no motor overloads since the current lubrication regimen was implemented, though excess operational friction continues.

Under the guidance of BCDD's engineer, BES coordinated an inspection and evaluation of the gates and lifting mechanism by Scott Snowdon, a pump station mechanical expert. Mr. Snowdon found no specific issue requiring immediate attention but recommended a rebuild of gear assemblies be scheduled during the first quarter of 2026. In addition, routine scheduled generator testing and maintenance service was completed on October 2 and reports were sent to both Pratt and BCDD. Finally, at Pratt's request, the monthly pump operation log format was modified to include generator run time.
